Festival Riviera - Nice, Monte Carlo

March - May 2011, Optional 3 day tour extension to Avignon

- Festival Gala Performance in Nice and optional choir performances in Rome and Monte Carlo
- Selections for the combined concert may include Mozart's Coronation Mass, Haydn's Te Deum, Handel's Coronation Anthems, and Britten's Gloriana
- Perform Mass at St Peter's Basilica (tbc)

ROME

Tour Ancient Rome, the Colosseum, Capitoline Hill, citadel of ancient Rome, the Tarpeian Rock and the Roman Forum. Visit the historical centre of Rome including Trevi Fountain, Spanish Steps, Piazza Navona and piazza Campo de' Fiori, We visit Vatican City and St Peter's Basilica.

NICE

We pass through Genoa famed for its ancient port and Lighthouse, the city centre's squares such as the Piazza della Vittoria and the Old Town including Porta Soprana and Cristoforo Columbo's House. Discover the "Promenade des Anglais", the Castle Park overlooking the Bay of Angels and Cimiez hill, famous for its Jazz Festival and monastery.

MONTE CARLO & RIVIERA

Tour Monte Carlo which is built on rocks 200ft. above the sea. Visit the most famous casino surrounded by beautiful gardens and flowered terraces. Visit Monte-Carlo's world-famous racetrack and the neo-Romanesque cathedral with the Princess Grace Memorial. Enjoy St Tropez and Cannes, renowned for the world's most prestigious film festival and its seafront boulevard, La Croisette.
