PRAGUE

Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of Prague including a walking tour of the old town and Prague Castle, St. Vitus Cathedral and the Charles Bridge.

VIENNA

Guided city tour of Vienna including Ring Avenue, the Hofburg Palace, the Opera House, St. Stephen's Cathedral, Mozart's "Figaro House", City Hall and the Central Cemetery (housing honorary tombs of famous composers). Enjoy a scenic drive to Salzburg to explore Mozart's birthplace which began as a Celtic settlement and then became a Roman town. Visit the outstanding "House of Music" to experience the The Great Masters of Viennese music tradition: Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert, Strauss, the Waltz Dice Game and The Vienna Philharmonic Museum.

Leading the festival is Dr. John Guthmiller. Dr. Guthmiller holds degrees in music education, music history and in the literature and performance of choral music. He is a 2003 recipient of the Distinguished Achievement in Teaching Award from the VCU School of the Arts. In 2008 he led triumphant performances of Carl Orff's Carmina Burana in Beijing and Shanghai, China.
